January 16	First day to file for place on General Election ballot or to file declaration of write-in candidacy with City Secretary 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (City Hall 301 East Market Street, Sinton, TX)
February 12	6:00 p.m. City Council Meeting to Call/Order the General Election
February 15	Last day to file application for place on General Election ballot or to file declaration of write-in candidacy with City Secretary 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Statutory Last Day for Ordering Election
February 22	Last day for candidate to withdraw and have name omitted from ballot
February 22	9:00 a.m. Drawing for place on ballot (at City Hall Council Chambers)
March 8	Extended deadline to file for a place on the ballot in a city office having a 4-year term if no one has filed by 5pm on Feb. 15(must be received by 5pm)
March 20	First day to mail early ballots, if available.
April 5	Due date for filing first report of contributions and expenditures with City Secretary (if modified reporting not elected)
April 19	Last day to receive application from voter in person for a ballot to be voted by mail
April 22 – April 30	Early voting by personal appearance at City Office (301 East Market Street, Sinton, Texas 78387) 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.
April 22 April 29	Early voting by personal appearance at City Office 12 hour days (City Hall 301 East Market, Sinton, TX) 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
April 23	Last day to receive application by mail for a ballot to be voted by mail
April 24	Last day for publication of Notice of Election
May 1	Last day to receive an application to cancel mail ballot by a person who does not return the ballot.
May 4	Election Day at Sinton Community Center 1301 E Sinton St. Sinton, Texas 78387 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
May 14	6:00 p.m. Regular City Council Meeting to canvass returns, issue Certificates of Election, and administer Statements of Elected Officer and Oaths of Office; Newly-elected officers assume duties.
