**To Elect Two (2) Councilmembers for a 4-year term  
Council Member Place 3 and Council Member Place 5**

<b>January 18</b>	<b>First day to file for place on General Election ballot or to file declaration of write-in candidacy with City Secretary 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (City Hall 301 East Market Street, Sinton, TX)</b>
<b>February 14</b>	<b>6:00 p.m. City Council Meeting to Call/Order the General Election</b>
<b>February 17</b>	<b>Last day to file application for place on General Election ballot or to file declaration of write-in candidacy with City Secretary 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.</b>
<b>February 17</b>	Statutory Last Day for Ordering Election. Post Public Notice for drawing.
<b>February 22</b>	9:00 a.m. Drawing for place on ballot (at City Hall Council Chambers)
<b>February 24</b>	Last day for candidate to withdraw, by submission of a notarized Certificate of Withdrawal or a notarized letter; and have name omitted from ballot.
<b>March 10</b>	Extended deadline to file for a place on the ballot in a city office having a 4-year term if no one has filed by 5pm on Feb. 17(must be filed by 5pm)
<b>March 22</b>	First day to mail early ballots, if available.
<b>April 2</b>	Last day to register to vote or make a change of address effective for the May 6, 2023 election.
<b>April 21</b>	<b>Last day to receive application from voter in person for a ballot to be voted by mail</b>
<b>April 24- May 2</b>	<b>Early voting by personal appearance at early voting location.</b>
<b>April 25</b>	Last day to accept application for a ballot to be voted by mail, by 12 noon or close of business, whichever is later.
<b>April 26</b>	Last day for publication of Notice of Election
<b>May 2</b>	Last day of regular early voting by personal appearance
<b>May 6</b>	<b>Election Day 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.</b>
<b>May 16</b>	6:00 p.m. Regular City Council Meeting to canvass returns, issue Certificates of Election, and administer Statements of Elected Officer and Oaths of Office; Newly-elected officers assume duties.
