

## “Stay Home Work Safe Measures”

On March 26, 2020 the Sinton City Council approved a Declaration of Local State of Disaster Due to Novel Coronavirus.

This Order is now in effect and will remain in place thru **April 9, 2020.**

The simplest definition of this Order is, **if you do not have a reason to be outside your home, stay home.**

If your employer is an exempted business, then your employer will notify you.

The Order does not prevent you from going out to obtain necessary supplies (food, cleaning supplies, pet supplies, and any other household consumer product) or delivering those supplies to someone else, going to the doctor, picking up meals at the school, exercising outside provided the individuals comply with social distancing requirements of six feet.

Local businesses that are impacted by this Order are:

Hair/nail salons

Barbers

Pawn Shops

Gift Shops

Jewelry Store

Chamber of Commerce/Visitor Center

Antique Shop

Other businesses are considered essential and may remain open.

Also, the Order suspends evictions and any foreclosures for at least the next 30 days.

The Order suspends bulk trash pick-up for April.

City buildings are closed to the public. Call City Hall 361-364-2381 for questions or appointments.

Just remember, if you do not have a reason to be away from your home, you and everyone else are safest if you remain indoors.
